

## BOUNDARIES

Wardcliff Neighborhood is bordered on the west by Brookfield Drive; Burcham Road to the north, E. Grand River Avenue to the south and Park Lake Road to the east.

- West side of E. Brookfield Dr. to Roseland Ave.
- East to Wardcliff Dr. (Including Leland Circle)
- Corner of Cahill Dr. & Timberlane St.
- Timberlane St. North (Properties on the east of street)
- East to Blue Haven Dr.
- North to Burcham Rd.
- East to Park Lake Rd.
- Park Lake Rd. (Properties on both sides) to E. Grand River Ave.
- West on E. Grand River Ave. (Properties on north side) to E. Brookfield Dr.
